- 1. Facilitate the production of basic English sounds:
 - 1.1. Say the letters of the alphabet and use spelling for clarification with increasing accuracy.
 - 1.2. Pronounce consonants, consonant blends, and vowel sounds with increasing accuracy.
 - 1.3. Produce –s/-es sounds with increasing accuracy.
 - 1.4. Demonstrate a basic understanding of –ed pronunciation.
- 2. Develop basic speaking ability for social and classroom purposes:
 - 2.1. Use common social expressions in short conversations.
 - 2.2. Make introductions following models studied in class.
 - 2.3. Ask for and give personal information, including addresses and telephone numbers, in short conversations.
 - 2.4. State cardinal numbers and ordinal numbers with increasing accuracy.
 - 2.5. Ask for and give time and dates in short conversations.
 - 2.6. Ask for prices and state money amounts with increasing accuracy in short conversations.
 - 2.7. Ask for and give simple directions in short conversations.
 - 2.8. Make statements and ask and answer questions using the simple present, present continuous, and simple past tenses.
 - 2.9. Effectively discuss daily routines and future plans in short conversations.
 - 2.10. Express likes and dislikes in short conversations.
 - 2.11. Express agreement and disagreement in short conversations.
 - 2.12. Describe events that happened in the past.
 - 2.13. Give and follow simple instructions in short conversations.
 - 2.14. Make emergency phone calls and describe emergency situations.
