



If you have been enrolled for at least 4 consecutive ELI sessions, you may request an annual vacation if you intend to enroll in the next session. If approved for a vacation, you may take 1 session off and still maintain valid F-1 status. During your annual vacation, you may stay in the United States or travel outside of the US.

Annual Vacation Eligibility:

- » Must be enrolled for 4 consecutive ELI sessions
» Must intend to enroll in the next session immediately after your annual vacation
» Must be in valid F-1 status
» Cannot take annual vacation after level 8
» Students in the Access UCF or Global Achievement Academy II or III programs are not eligible for Annual Vacation
