 - 1.4. Use subject and object pronouns.
 - 1.5. Use articles and adjectives.
 - 1.6. Use simple present and present progressive verb forms.
 - 1.7. Use affirmative and negative sentences.
 - 1.8. Create and answer questions.
 - 1.9. Use contractions.
 - 1.10Use adverbs of frequency and manner.
 - 1.11 Write general information sentences and detail sentences.
