

A Social Security Number (SSN) is required to report wages to the U.S. Government. International students, scholars and professionals are eligible to apply for a SSN only if they have an offer of employment. Applications must be done in person at the Social Security Administration Office.

THE FOLLOWING DOCUMENTS ARE REQUIRED TO APPLY FOR A SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER:

- » A completed Social Security Card Application (available at the Social Security office or online at <http://www.socialsecurity.gov/online/ss-5.pdf>)
- » Valid passport
- » Current I-94 card
- » J-1 visa or F-1 visa (if applicable)
- » DS-2019 form with port of entry stamp and most current DS-2019 or I-20 form reflecting “Continued Attendance” under the certificate issuance section
- » Birth certificate (certified or original) if available
- » Proof of employment eligibility (employment verification letter certified by an advisor at ISC)

IMPORTANT POINTS TO REMEMBER

- » Must submit a copy of your Social Security card receipt letter to ISC
(This will be provided to you the day you apply at the SSA office)
- » Must submit a copy of your signed Social Security card to ISC upon receipt in the mail

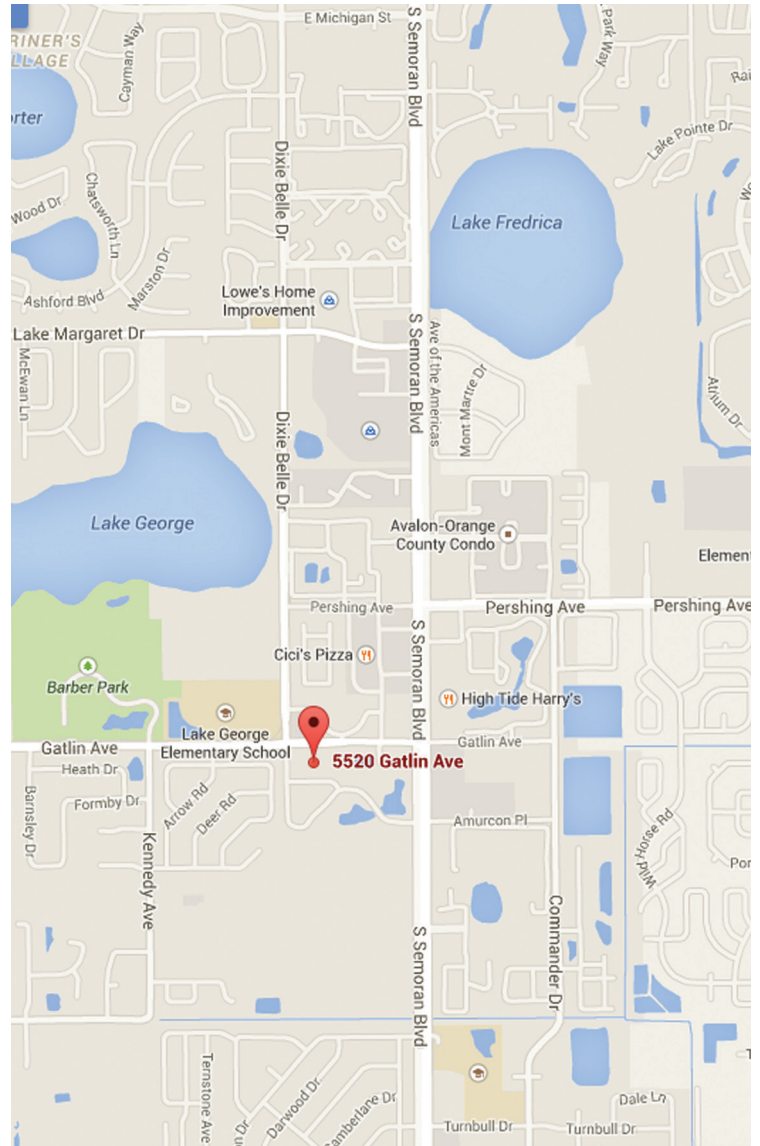
