



Goal, Objectives, and Student Learning Outcomes

Level 2 – Listening/Speaking/Pronunciation

Goal:

Build communication skills through extensive listening, speaking and pronunciation practice on everyday topics, and thematic units.

Objectives (functions/ structures taught)

- Building everyday vocabulary
- Recognizing stressed syllables
- Demonstrating understanding of a listening through class discussions, comprehension questions and assessments
- Listening for key words
- Listening for specific information
- Restating key ideas
- Stating information about self, school and world
- Answering questions, orally, on every day and thematic topics
- Utilizing graphic organizers to take notes
- Identifying time frames of present, past and future in a listening.
- Providing information about past, present and future activities
- Distinguishing between word endings for the simple past tense
- Identifying reductions in speech
- Identifying differences in intonation patterns

Student Learning Outcomes (SLOs) (measured/assessed/ mastered)

- Identify main ideas in a conversation or broadcast on thematic topics
- Restate main ideas and details in a listening on a familiar topic
- Roleplay a conversation on present, past and future activities
- Distinguish the pronunciation between -ed word endings
- Describe activities and events in spoken English, utilizing A2 vocabulary and North American intonation patterns.
