- » ALL HIGH SCHOOL TRANSCRIPTS, TRANSLATIONS (2.5 minimum GPA) and DIPLOMA (if applicable)
- » OFFICIAL ENGLISH EXAM SCORE REPORT (TOEFL, IELTS, iTEP - scores determine placement)
- » ACCELERATED CREDITS such as IB, AP, AICE, AS/A Level, CAPE or CLEP (if applicable)
- » POSTSECONDARY CREDITS and Course-by-Course CREDENTIAL EVALUATION with GPA CALCULATION (if applicable) (2.5 minimum GPA)
- » Completed and signed APPLICATION CHECKLIST
- » Copy of PASSPORT
- » Supporting Financial Documents
- » Affidavit of Support
- \$120 application fee



ADMISSION RESTRICTIONS

- » We do accept:
 - » Dual-citizens who have completed high school outside of US
 - » F-1 students with <2 years of high school in US (outside of FL)
 - » Transfer credit from universities outside of Florida
 - » Online students

- » We do <u>not</u> accept:
 - » Students from Florida high schools, colleges or universities



KEY MAJOR LIMITATIONS

- » Pathway students are accepted to UCF, but not necessarily all majors
 - » Some majors have additional admissions requirements or pre-requisite courses
 - » Ex. Computer Science BS


