

# The Lewis Foundation Scholarship

The Lewis Foundation Scholarship will award international students from the Bahamas up to \$25,000! This scholarship will cover all educational expenses for one academic year including tuition at the resident rate, living expenses, and other fees from the University. This unique scholarship is renewable for four years based on the student maintaining good academic standing at the university.

## CONSIDERATIONS

A total of eight (8) applicants will be selected for the Lewis Foundation Scholarship award for the Fall 2022 and Spring 2023 semesters.

- » Fall 2022 – 4 awardees
- » Spring 2023 – 4 awardees

Selected applicants will be given a time period to accept the award upon notification; in the event of decline (or non-reply), alternate, qualified awardees may be selected. Awardees will be considered tentative until UCF admission and enrollment is verified.

**Please note:** The Lewis Foundation Scholarship may be used for fall and spring semesters only (it cannot be awarded for summer semesters).

## APPLICATION CYCLE

### Fall 2022

- » March 29, 2022 Application Period Opens
- » **June 24, 2022** Application Period Closes

### Spring 2023

- » August 1, 2022 Application Period Opens
- » **October 28, 2022** Application Period Closes

The Lewis Foundation Scholarship will be only available to UCF applicants and current students. Bahamian students will have to fill out our Lewis Foundation Scholarship Application at <https://tinyurl.com/LewisFoundationApplication> before the application period closes.

## CRITERIA

To be eligible to apply for “The Lewis Foundation Scholarship”, the following criteria must be met:

- » Applicants must be citizens coming from the Bahamas and must have graduated from a high school located in the Bahamas.
- » Applicants must demonstrate financial need through supporting documentation.
- » Applicants must demonstrate and maintain good academic standing. (3.0 GPA).
- » Awarded students must be enrolled full time in a bachelor’s degree program. (12 credits).
- » Awarded students must have a current and valid immigration status.
- » Preference will be given to first time in college students.
- » Preference will be given to students who have transferred from the University of the Bahamas.
