Interpretation of Achievement Scale – Foundational Reading Level 1

The goal of Reading Level 1 is for students to build foundational skills in reading in North American English.

Foundational Reading Level 1 Teaching Objectives:

- 1. Building everyday vocabulary on self and school.
- 2. Recognizing sound to letter correspondences.
- 3. Developing strategies to read and comprehend foundational reading passages, including skimming and scanning;
- 4. Identify basic factual statements relating to pictures or simple texts
- 5. Recognizing cardinal numbers 1 100
- 6. Recognizing basic sentences describing everyday objects (e.g. color, size), given visual support.
- 7. Identify short, simple descriptors of objects, people and animals, given visual support.
- 8. Following short, simple written directions (from X to Y).
- 9. Identify simple phrases in short, simple reading passages.
- 10. Identify simple descriptions of places.
- 11. Identify simple written notices, signs and instructions with visual support.
- 12. Identify short, simple messages about when and where to meet.
- 13. Following simple instructions to carry out a straightforward task. (e.g. create a personal schedule)
- 14. Identify simple phrases related to familiar, everyday activities.
- 15. Identify familiar phases in a simple reading passage.

- 4. Acquire and utilize vocabulary at the A1 level.
