Course Objectives, Student Learning Outcomes, and Promotion Requirements

Interpretation of Achievement Scale – Foundational Reading Level 2

The goal of Reading Level 2 is for students to expand foundational skills in reading through extensive reading of multi-paragraphed text at the A1+ level.

Foundational Reading Level 2 Teaching Objectives:

- 1. Using context clues to guess meaning of unknown words
- 2. Developing everyday vocabulary related to self, school, work, and society
- 3. Demonstrating comprehension of a reading passage through class discussions, comprehension questions and assessments
- 4. Identifying and following basic instructions for academic purposes
- 5. Skimming for the main idea of a reading passage
- 6. Scanning for specific information within a passage
- 7. Summarizing short readings on familiar topics
- 8. Recognizing basic sentences describing everyday objects (e.g. color, size), given visual support.
- 9. Recognizing short descriptors of objects, people and animals, given visual support.
- 10. Following simple written directions (from X to Y).
- 11. Identifying simple phrases in simple reading passages.
- 12. Identifying factual statements relating to pictures or simple reading passages.
- 13. Following instructions in a simple academic reading passage in order to carry out a straightforward task.
- 14. Identifying phrases related to familiar, everyday activities.
- 15. Recognizing familiar phases in a simple reading passage.

- 2. Distinguish between main ideas and details in a reading passage at the A1+ level
- 3. Identify specific information, such as names, cities, numbers, and dates, by scanning a reading passage at the A1+ level
- 4. Acquire and utilize vocabulary at the A1+ level.
