# Course Objectives, Student Learning Outcomes, and Promotion Requirements

### Interpretation of Achievement Scale - Academic Reading Level 5

The goal of Academic Reading Level 5 is to develop students' ability to read and analyze simplified academic passages.

### **Academic Reading Level 5 Teaching Objectives:**

- 1. Increasing comprehension of key vocabulary, specifically those words that can be found on the Academic Word List
- 2. Demonstrating comprehension of a longer reading passage through class discussions, comprehension questions and assessments
- 3. Skimming a multi-paragraphed academic reading to identify key concepts
- 4. Scanning for specific information of a multi-paragraph academic reading passage
- 5. Previewing and drawing conclusions from the information found in multi-paragraph academic readings
- 6. Inferring unstated information in a multi-paragraph academic reading passage
- 7. Using strategies to increase reading speed
- 8. Summarizing multi-paragraphed academic readings orally and in writing
- 9. Identifying supporting ideas
- 10. Distinguishing between fact and opinions
- 11. Distinguishing between causes and effects
- 12. Identifying meaning of new words through context
- 13. Recognizing the author's point of view
- 14. Predicting the content of a multi-paragraph academic text using headings, images, and captions
- 15. Distinguishing the relationship between main points and examples

- 2. Identify author's purpose and argument in a multi-paragraphed academic reading passage at the B1 level.
- 3. Distinguish between main ideas and details in an academic reading passage at the B1 Level
- 4. Summarize main ideas of a reading passage at the B1 Level, in writing.
- 5. Infer author's meaning from a reading passage at the B1 Level.
- 6. Distinguish between facts and opinions in a reading passage.
- 7. Identify the organizational structure of a reading passage at the B1 level
- 8. Acquire and utilize vocabulary at the B1 level.
