Interpretation of Achievement Scale - Academic Reading Level 6

The goal of Academic Reading Level 6 is to expose students to a variety of academic texts with a focus on analyzing a text for author's purpose and meaning.

Academic Reading Level 6 Teaching Objectives:

- 1. Develop key vocabulary, specifically for argumentation
- 2. Demonstrating comprehension of longer academic reading passages through class discussions, comprehension questions and assessments
- 3. Skimming and scanning for gist, details of emerging multi-paragraph academic readings
- 4. Previewing, inferencing, drawing conclusions from emerging multi-paragraph academic readings
- 5. Summarizing emerging multi-paragraph academic readings orally and in writing
- 6. Identifying supporting ideas
- 7. Distinguishing between facts and opinions
- 8. Distinguishing between arguments and counter arguments
- 9. Identifying meanings of new words through context
- 10. Recognizing the organizational structure of content in an emerging multi-paragraph academic reading
- 11. Identifying the sources of information in emerging multi-paragraph academic readings
- 12. Recognizing common discourse markers that convey emphasis in emerging multi-paragraph academic readings
- 13. Distinguishing whether an author is quoting or paraphrasing in emerging, multi-paragraph academic readings
- 14. Identifying the key information presented in graphs and charts
- 15. Distinguishing among different viewpoints in emerging multi-paragraph academic readings
- 16. Identifying and following chronological order of events based on numbers, dates, or times
- 17. Recognizing contrasting ideas based on the identification of specific discourse markers

- 4. Paraphrase main ideas and details in an emerging academic reading passage at the B1+ level
- 5. Identify the organizational structure of a reading text at the B1+ level
- 6. Acquire and utilize vocabulary at the B1+ level.
