Interpretation of Achievement Scale - Advanced Reading Level 8

The goal of Advanced Reading Level 8 is to expose students to a wide variety of academic reading passages, further developing students' ability to analyze and synthesize sources. Students will develop their ability to summarize, paraphrase, and synthesize ideas taken from academic reading passages.

Advanced Reading Level 8 Teaching Objectives:

- 1. Increasing development of academic vocabulary; differentiating between discipline-specific terms and general academic terms
- 2. Demonstrating comprehension of longer academic reading passages through class discussions, comprehension questions and assessments
- 3. Skimming and scanning for gist and details in an academic article
- 4. Previewing, inferencing, drawing conclusions from academic reading passage
- 5. Using strategies to increase reading speed
- 6. Summarizing multi-paragraphed reading passages succinctly and concisely
- 7. Determining the validity of an argument
- 8. Distinguishing valid and invalid sources
- 9. Identifying meaning of new words through context
- 10. Inferring the author's opinion in a longer academic reading passage
- 11. Identifying the author's tone in a longer academic reading passage
- 12. Identifying different types of supporting details in a longer academic reading passage
- 13. Recognizing common discourse markers that convey emphasis in a longer academic reading passage
- 14. Evaluating the main points of an academic argument on an unfamiliar topic
- 15. Taking effective notes on a longer academic reading passage
- 16. Distinguishing between different viewpoints in a longer academic reading text

- 4. Utilize context clues to determine discipline-specific terms and phrases
- 5. Acquire and utilize vocabulary at the B2+ level.

Advanced Reading Level 8 Requirements for Promotion
