Course Objectives, Student Learning Outcomes, and Promotion Requirements

Interpretation of Achievement Scale - Advanced Writing Level 8

The goals of Advanced Writing Level 8 are for students to develop researched essay writing skills and learn to identify and cite academic sources in APA citation style to avoid plagiarism.

Advanced Writing Level 8 Teaching Objectives:

- 1. Improve planning, drafting, revising, and reflecting on writing in academic contexts, incorporating paraphrases and quotes using APA citation;
 - a. Utilize various writing techniques in research writing: paraphrasing, summarizing, synthesizing.
- 2. Produce writing that effectively uses appropriate conventions, formats, and language in different academic contexts;
- 3. Identify and report on different resources (a minimum of 3) and technologies to support how they think, learn, and communicate points of view in an academic fashion;
 - a. Use search engines and databases.
 - b. Identify and use primary versus secondary sources
- 4. Increase awareness of advanced grammatical structures in reading and writing (e.g., reduced noun, adjective, and adverb clauses; advanced discourse markers; conditionals)
- 5. Develop writing skills using academic models for various rhetorical patterns (i.e., cause/effect & argumentative)

Advanced Writing Level 8 Student Learning Outcomes to Formally Assess:

Upon successful completion of this course, students will be able to:

- 1. Employ strategies to develop writing processes through planning, writing, and editing multiparagraph essays.
- 2. Analyze and edit their own writing processes, with assistance, developing skills in identifying cultural conventions and grammatical and lexical choices.
- 3. Compose a five-paragraph essay in each of these rhetorical modes: cause and effect and argumentative; employing North American conventions
- 4. Employ techniques by creating successive drafts that show global and local improvement and incorporate feedback from peers and instructor.
- 5. Employ academic vocabulary for varied writing contexts.
- 6. Evaluate academic situations to adapt word choice.
