Foundational Grammar Level 1 Teaching Objectives:

:Develop and reinforce foundational grammar skills that include mastery of the form and usage of:

- 1. Simple present verb tense in affirmative and negative statements and questions
- 2. Yes/No and information questions
- 3. Singular and plural forms of regular and irregular nouns
- 4. Indefinite articles a, an
- 5. Subject pronouns
- 6. Demonstrative adjectives and pronouns (this/that/these/those)
- 7. Prepositions of time and place
- 8. The determiner there + (be)
- 9. Adverbs of frequency
- 10. Present progressive verb tense
- 11. Basic capitalization and punctuation for declarative and interrogative sentences
