Foundational Grammar Level 2 Teaching Objectives:

Develop and reinforce foundational grammar skills that include the form and usage of:

- 1. Present and past tenses (simple and progressive)
- 2. Possessive nouns and adjectives
- 3. Object pronouns
- 4. Count and non-count nouns and appropriate quantifiers
- 5. Imperatives
- 6. Modals
- 7. Simple future tense

- 1. Recognize and produce sentences, demonstrating comprehension of the simple future tense in both oral and written form.
- 2. Recognize and produce sentences demonstrating comprehension of the present tense verbs in their simple and progressive forms in both oral and written form
- 3. Recognize and produce sentences demonstrating comprehension of the past tense verbs in their simple and progressive forms in both oral and written form.
- 4. Integrate the forms and meanings of possessives in simple sentences in both oral and written form.
- 5. Identify object pronouns in both oral and written form.
- 6. Differentiate between direct and indirect objects and demonstrate control of SVO word order in simple and compound sentences in both oral and written form.
