<u>Interpretation of Achievement Scale – Low-intermediate Grammar Level 3</u>

The goal of Low-intermediate Grammar Level 3 is for students to acquire and practice low-intermediate grammar structures.

Students will study and reinforce low intermediate grammar skills that include the form and usage of:

- 1 Present and past tenses (simple and progressive including negative and question forms)
- 2 Future tense (simple and progressive including negative and question forms)
- 3 Habitual past
- 4 Adverb clauses of time
- 5 There + be
- 6 Subject and object pronouns
- 7 Possessive adjectives, nouns, and pronouns
- 8 Direct and indirect objects
