High-intermediate Grammar Level 6 Teaching Objectives:

Students will develop advanced intermediate grammar skills that include the form and usage of:

- Adjective clauses
 - 1. Using who, whom or that to describe people
 - 2. Using that, which or Æ to describe things
 - 3. Using subject-verb agreement
 - 4. Using prepositions
 - 5. Using whose to show possession
- · Adverb clauses related to cause and effect and contrast
- Coordinating and subordinating conjunctions
- Passive voice
