Advanced Grammar Level 8 Teaching Objectives:

Students will develop advanced grammar skills that include the form and usage of:

1. Adjective clauses and phrases
2. Noun clauses and their use in reported speech
 - a. Subjunctives in noun clauses
3. Adverb clauses and adverbial phrases
4. Connectives that reflect cause and effect, purpose, contrast, and condition
5. Structures that reflect real/unreal and implied conditions in different tenses (time-permitting)
6. Structures that reflect present, past, and future wishes (time-permitting)
