# Course Objectives, Student Learning Outcomes, and Promotion Requirements

### Interpretation of Achievement Scale - Everyday Communication Skills Level 3

The goal of Everyday Communication Skills Level 3 is to develop students' ability to communicate on familiar topics related to school, daily life, and self. Further develop listening skills to understand conversations and short passages.

## **Everyday Communication Skills Level 3 Teaching Objectives:**

- 1. Listen for and identify main ideas in a listening on a familiar topic.
- 2. Determine the number of syllables in a word. Employ rules of syllable stress.
- 3. Differentiate numbers when listening
- 4. Predict information in a listening passage or short video.
- 5. Listen for and identify details and supporting information in short, simple stories or conversations.
- 6. Listen for simple signposts. E.g. first, second, in addition, finally, next, etc.
- 7. Use descriptive language (frequent adjectives, adverbs) when speaking about a topic.
- 8. Negotiate meaning with group members to complete a task
- 9. Give and respond to suggestions on everyday events and actions.
- 10. Describe present, past and future activities related to school and leisure.
- 11. Listen for and give reasons.
- 12. Identify stress in words and sentences.
- 13. Listen for and identify contractions.
- 14. Listen for and distinguish between statements and questions based on intonation patterns.
- 15. Participate in a conversation on familiar, everyday topics.
- 16. Ask for repetition
- 17. Prepare and present a short presentation on a familiar topic. E.g. family, vacation, etc.
- 18. Distinguish between -ed endings (/t/, /d/, /id/)
- 19. Distinguish between s ending (/s/, /z/, /iz/)
- 20. Identify a sequence of events with support of cue words
- 21. Summarize events in a story chronologically
- 22. Recognize agreement and disagreement in a listening
- 23. Describe skills and abilities with simple language

## **Everyday Communication Skills Level 3 Student Learning Outcomes to Formally Assess:**

Upon successful completion of this course, students will be able to:

- 1. Prepare and deliver a short formal presentation on a common topic, using simple transitional markers.
- 2. Recall and restate events in a short conversation or listening at the A2 Level.
- 3. Determine speakers' main ideas and supporting details at the A2 level.
- 4. Determine the meaning of key vocabulary words in a listening passage on a familiar topic.
- 5. Identify implied meanings and infer the speaker's intentions in level-appropriate listening passages.
- 6. Employ conversational strategies such as turn-taking and questioning during a classroom discussion.
- 7. Identify and produce word endings (-ed endings; -s endings) correctly in listening and speaking.
