Course Objectives, Student Learning Outcomes, and Promotion Requirements

Interpretation of Achievement Scale - Academic Communication Skills Level 5

The goal of Academic Communication Skills Level 5 is for students to continue to strengthen their listening comprehension to understand conversational speech and simplified academic presentations. They continue to develop their ability to deliver a formal presentation.

Academic Communication Skills Level 5 Teaching Objectives:

- 1. Make predictions about listening passages.
- 2. Organize notes from a listening source into an outline
- 3. Correctly identify topics and subtopics in listening passages.
- 4. Recognize examples in listening passages
- 5. Identify key words and discourse cues in listening passages.
- 6. Listen for details in academic presentations.
- 7. Identify reduced speech.
- 8. Express agreement or disagreement during a discussion.
- 9. Identify stressed content words in a conversation.
- 10. Ask for and state an opinion.
- 11. Provide detailed support for an opinion
- 12. Prepare and deliver personal experience speech.
- 13. Employ presentation skills to convey information and express ideas on a topic
- 14. Connect with the audience when presenting.
- 15. Identify causes and effects in listening and speaking.
- 16. Distinguish facts from opinions.
- 17. Infer speaker's opinion
- 18. Identify and use clarification language
- 19. Distinguish between advantages and disadvantages in a listening and speaking task
- 20. Summarize key points when speaking
- 21. Use persuasive language E.g. modals, tone, etc.
- 22. Express hopes, wishes and desires
- 23. Report the opinions of others, including those from a listening passage
- 24. Participate in a class discussion by contributing through turn-taking strategies

Upon successful completion of this course, students will be able to:

- 1. Prepare and deliver a formal presentation with an introduction, body and conclusion and appropriate transitional markers.
- 2. Employ strategies such as turn-taking, clarification requests, and elaboration during discussions.
- 3. Identify main ideas and distinguish them from supporting ideas, details, and examples in an academic passage at the B1 level.
- 4. Determine the meaning of key vocabulary words in a listening passage.
- 5. Use notes from a lecture to summarize main ideas.
- 6. Identify implied meanings and infer the speaker's intentions and opinions in level-appropriate listening passages.
