



# UCF Global MPT INSTRUCTIONS

Welcome, Global Knight! UCF Global and the University of Central Florida are committed to your success. Therefore, we want to make certain that you are enrolled in classes according to your skills.

All UCF students need to take a Math Placement Test (MPT). This test will determine the right math class and sequence for you. You can both study for and take the MPT before arriving at UCF.

You can read about, study, and practice for the test as many times as desired before taking the exam. We are asking that you take the actual test **ONLY** once and send us the scores before arrival. The actual test will become available in the online testing module once you get a minimum score of 30 on the practice test. If you are unable to get 30 on the practice test, continue practicing and your academic advisor will help place you in the appropriate math class for your skill level upon arrival. All students will be given a second opportunity to take the test during orientation week.

Please take advantage of having this information to help you study and prepare before you arrive. If you choose not to study and take the test before arrival, you will have to do so during orientation which is not to your advantage. You need to take this test seriously, so the score accurately reflects your real skills and knowledge of mathematics.

In order to both practice and take the test, please follow these steps:

1. Verify your NID

2. Verify your UCF ID

- a. In order to get your UCF ID you need your Acceptance letter. Your UCF ID number is listed on the top of your Acceptance letter.
